State Police Investigate Fatal Motor Vehicle Crash

Lower Milford Township, Lehigh County – The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Troop M – Fogelsville Patrol Unit is investigating a fatal motor vehicle crash that occurred on Monday, December 2, 2024.

On Monday, December 2, 2024, at approximately 4:19 am, Troopers were dispatched to the area of Kings Highway South and the intersection of Janes Lane, Lower Milford Township, Lehigh County for the report of a motor vehicle crash. Upon arrival, Troopers observed the vehicle on fire.

Upon investigation, it is determined, the 2014 Toyota Sienna, operated by a 38-Year-Old Male from Lower Milford Township, was traveling northbound on Kings Highway South, when the vehicle struck a tree located off the roadway, and the vehicle caught fire.

The operator was pronounced deceased at the scene and was the sole occupant of the vehicle. There were no other reported injuries.

Fogelsville Patrol Unit is investigating this crash. Assisting at the scene: Troop M Forensic Services Unit, Lehigh County Coroners Office, East Greenville Fire Company and PENNDOT.
