ORDINANCE NO. 74

TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the Township of Lower Milford, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, establishing regulations for the public street system of Lower Milford Township.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Milford Township, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session and duly assembled as follows:

Section I SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Traffic Ordinance of Lower Milford Township."

Section II VEHICULAR PARKING

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle or appurtenance, whether licensed or unlicensed, upon any roadway within the Township of Lower Milford except in the case of a disabled vehicle.

B. Disabled vehicles must be removed from the roadway within 48 hours or will be considered abandoned in accordance with Title 75, Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes (Vehicle Code).

C. Temporary parking along the public roadway for purposes of driveway maintenance, social gatherings, "yard" sales, and similar activities will be permitted, not to exceed 48 hours.

D. For the purposes of this ordinance, a roadway shall include any public; street, alley, cul-de-sac or turn-around within said right-of-way, and shall apply to all public roadways, whether posted as "No Parking" or not posted.

Section III STREET RIGHT\_OF\_WAYS

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to plant, construct, or erect any man-made or natural object within the right-of-way of any roadway.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a licensed or unlicensed motor vehicle, motorcycle, mini-bike, go-cart, all terrain vehicle, snowmobile or tractor upon any public sidewalk except to gain ingress or egress at a location where the curb is depressed for that purpose. Nothing contained herein shall prohibit the use of snow plows for the purpose of snow removal from sidewalks.

C. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in roller-skating, rollerblading, skateboarding, the use of a coaster or other toy vehicle upon any roadway, with the exception that a pedestrian may pull a toy vehicle with or without a rider on a public sidewalk or roadway shoulder where no sidewalk is available.

Section IV PENALTIES

Any person found in violation of this ordinance, shall be cited, and upon conviction before the District Magistrate, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$25.00 per day for each violation, plus costs.

Section V REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section VI SEVERABILITY

If any sentence, clause, section or other part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Milford Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included herein.

Section VII AUTHORITY

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be upon adoption by the Board of Supervisors, as approved, ordained and enacted into an Ordinance of the Township of Lower Milford, Lehigh County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on this 8th day of AUGUST, 1996.
